## *About Injustice Anywhere*

Following the fatal shooting of young adult Michael Brown on August 9, 2014, by Ferguson police officer Darren Wilson, several Disciples clergy and laypersons joined many others in community responses for justice in

Ferguson and beyond. The documentary film *Injustice Anywhere* arose in the midst of conversations and work of several expressions of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) to share a story of collective experiences from individuals impacted by these events.

Social justice is not just "their" problem; it's everyone's concern. We reference the quote from the Rev.
